ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The Ranger must be at least 21 years old. This person must also have completed Safeguarding Youth training, AB506 training, First Aid Training, CPR/AED training, and Planning and Preparing for Hazardous Weather Training. This individual will work closely with the Facilities Manager and Head Ranger to identify maintenance and safety concerns before they become an issue.

- Conduct routine inspections, perform repairs, and ensure all buildings, utilities, and program areas meet safety and operational standard per the Facilities Manager and Head Ranger.
- Maintain Campsites, trails, and common areas to provide a safe, welcoming environment for campers and staff.
- Be particularly alert to conditions that affect health, safety, sanitation, and good housekeeping practices.
- Coordinate daily tasks and long-term projects with the Facilities Manager and Head Ranger to support overall camp operations.
- Respond to facility-relations concerns promptly and implement effective solutions to prevent recurring problems.
- Ensure trash and garbage disposal.
- Attend the leader's meetings and staff meetings as needed.
- Always be available on the radio while on site.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Facilities Manager and Head Ranger.
- All other duties as assigned.
