2. Make a list of items you should take along the activity selected in requirement 1. Take your Six Essentials Requirement 2	3. Determine a good spot for the tent and explain to your den leader why you picked it. Requirement 4	5. Demonstrate how to tie two half hitches and explain what the hitch is used for. Requirement 5 Optional	6. Learn how to read a thermometer and a barometer. Keep track of the temperature and the barometric pressure readings and the actual weather at the same time every day for seven days. Requirement 6 Optional	7. Discover and learn about three types of fish in your area. Draw a color picture of each fish, record what each one likes to eat, and describe what sort of habitat each one likes. Requirement 1	8. Learn about your local fishing regulations with your den leader or a parent or Guardian. List three of the regulations you learn about and one reason each regulation exists. Requirement 2
9. Learn about fishing equipment and make a simple fishing pole. Practice casting at a target. Requirement 3	10. If possible, go on a fishing adventure, and spending minimum of one hour trying to catch a fish. Put into practice the things you have learned about fishing and fishing equipment. Requirement 4	11. Discuss with your family or den the history of marbles, such as where and when the game began. Talk about the different sizes of marbles and what they are made of and used for. Requirement 1	12. Learn about three different Marble games and learn to play one of them. Learn how to keep score. Learn and follow the rules of the game period play the game with your family. Requirement 2	13.
