In addition, he spent a summer at Sichuan Union University in Chengdu, China, where he studied Chinese history and language. Bob served a four-year term as a board member for Goodwill Orange County, one of the largest Goodwill operations in the world, and has previously served on the board of Academy of Hope, an adult education and charter school organization in Washington, D.C. He is a current member of the Board of Counselors for USC's Marshall School of Business Masters in Business for Veterans program and an emeritus member of the USC Alumni Association Board of Governors. A licensed (but inactive) CPA in the Commonwealth of Virginia and an avid traveler, Bob has spent at least one night in 70 countries and counting. He is an Eagle Scout. 
