Are you compliant with the state-mandated reporter requirements? In 2022, California required mandated reporter training and fingerprinting. All registered BSA volunteer positions must comply with AB506. What does it mean to meet the AB506 requirements? First, the mandated reporter training is met by completing the 2-hour online training provided by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the Social Services at this link: https://mandatedreporterca.com/training/volunteers. Second, the Live Scan background check must be done.


