Required Registration Paperwork Before Attendance is Allowed

- Completed religious emblems application including your pastor's signature.
- Current BSA YPT certificate
- Current VIRTUS certificate or equivalent Diocesan Youth Protection Training.
- Current BSA registration proof (Please note that to register with BSA a separate LiveScan Fingerprinting with your BSA Council will also be necessary in California)
- Proof of LiveScan Fingerprinting completion with the Archdiocese of Los Angeles or equivalent.
- Your intent to teach form including the number of proposed students and when you propose to begin teaching. I will
 forward this to your Catholic Scouting Council Chair. (waived for Counselors outside of the Archdiocese of Los
 Angeles)
- California AB506 Mandated Reporter Training completion certificate (waived for Counselors outside of the state of California).
- Catholic Scouting Volunteer Application with Logo 2021 (Please note this is necessary annually except during the year providing the religious emblems application which is renewed every 3 years)
