



Have you completed your AB506 2-hour volunteer training? Have you done your fingerprinting (Live Scan)? This is the time to have your unit 100% trained. Unit Leaders, where do you rank?

Our District is below average when it comes to being fingerprinted and trained. You can help us reach our goal of 100% compliance with the State requirements. If registered adults have not complied with the law they will be in jeopardy of being dropped from the unit's roster. Don't lose your registration status.

WHAT CAN I DO TO GET OUR UNIT TO 100%?

- 1. Take the 2-hour volunteer training at: https://californiascouting.org/
- 2. Get your fingerprinting done!
- 3. Clear any unit discrepancies.
