- Sew emblems on scout uniforms according to customer and BSA specifications.
- Sew emblems on scout uniforms for pre-sewn shirt sales according to store specifications.
- Greet and assist customers in a friendly and professional manner, providing product information and answering inquiries about the Boy Scouts organization.
- Maintain a clean and organized sales floor, ensuring that merchandise is properly displayed and stocked.
- Maintain a clean and organized work area.
- Help customers in selecting merchandise based on their needs and preferences, offering guidance and suggestions as appropriate.
- Process sales transactions accurately and efficiently, handling cash, credit card, and other payment methods.
