Safety Reminders

- Safeguarding Youth Training (SYT) Update and Yearly Renewal (David Tran) Many of us will have YPT expiring soon, so please remind everyone to take the new SYT. The Course has had its content and subject matter updated. It is also more user friendly, and is now an annual training requirement. Also, remind people to take Foul-Weather training if it has expired for them. Go to your "My Training" when you log into My.Scouting.org and click on the course buttons to take the training.
- Foul Weather Training (Course SCO_800) (David Tran) The (online) training expires every 2 years! Be sure to check your training status and retake it as necessary because it is required for attending outdoor Scouting activities.
 - This is all the more important given the recent severe weather and flooding in the Midwest and South.
 - Log into your My. Scouting accounting, go to your "My Training" page and "retake" the Foul Weather training course to renew the expiration date.

Don't wait until the last moment as it can sometimes take months for an Organization to decide and get the approvals to be a CO.
