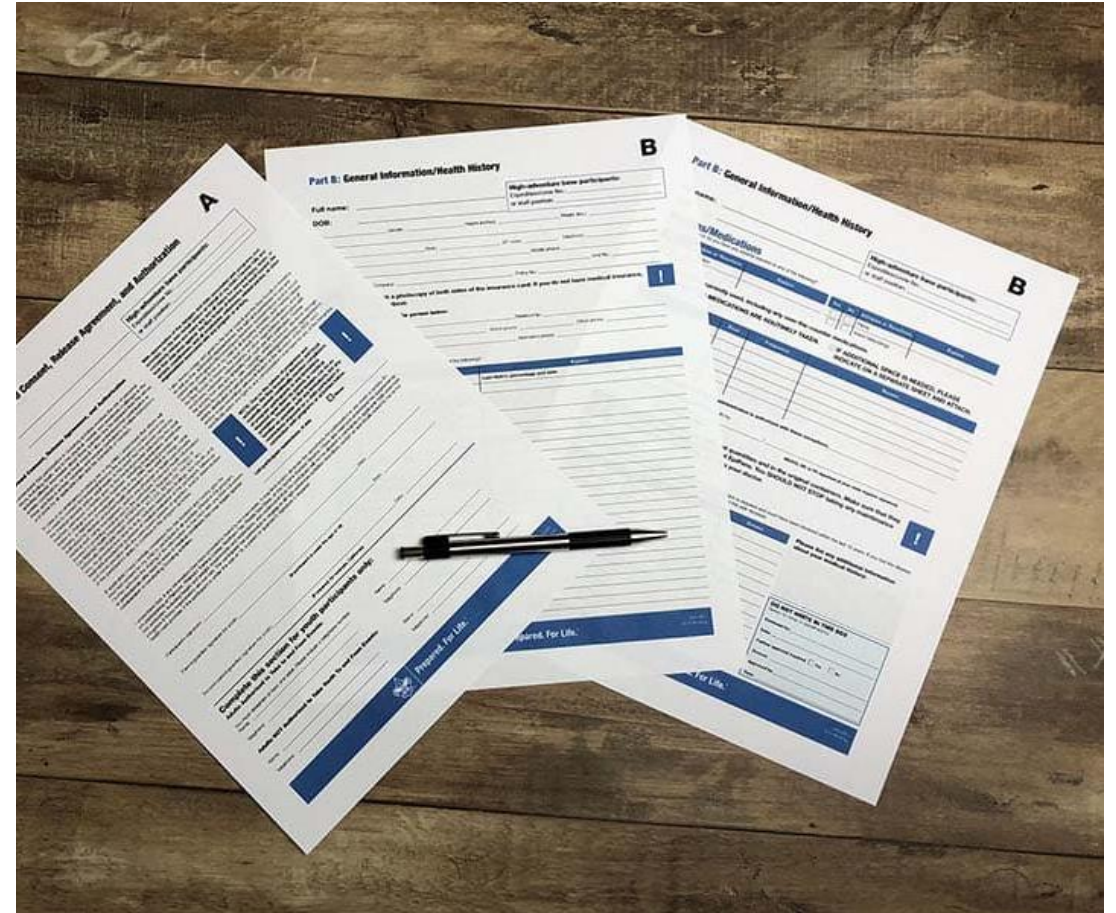

Safety Minute

Health and Safety Preparation

- Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR):
 - Parts A, B, and C
 - Importance of accurate and updated health information for all participants.
 - Importance of keeping these forms confidential and readily available in the event of an emergency.



Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR):

No. Please do not digitize!

- The electronic version should not be transmitted via email or stored electronically by units, districts, or councils.
- Units are encouraged to keep paper copies of their participants' AHMRs in a confidential medical file for quick access in an emergency and in preparation for all adventures.

• Designated Leader:

- A designated leader should be responsible for managing the forms and ensuring they are correctly stored.

• Returning Records:

- The AHMR should be returned to the participant or their parent/guardian when they leave the unit or when the documents become outdated.

• What you cannot do:

- **Do not transmit or store forms electronically:** by units, districts, or councils.
- **Do not email:** the completed forms.
- **Do not scan:** paper copies for electronic storage by the unit.

Health and Safety Preparation

- **Pre-Event Medical Screening:**
 - Before any event, conduct a quick health check of all participants, adults and youth, to ensure they are well enough to attend and do not pose a risk of spreading illness.
- **Medication Management:**
 - Safe storage, labeling, and administration of all medications, including emergency medications like asthma inhalers and EpiPens.
 - Create clear plans for who will manage and supervise a youth's medication, especially for those who cannot self-administer.

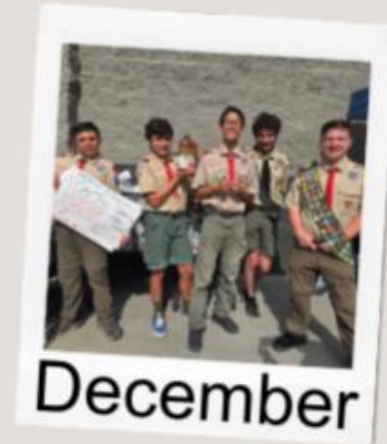

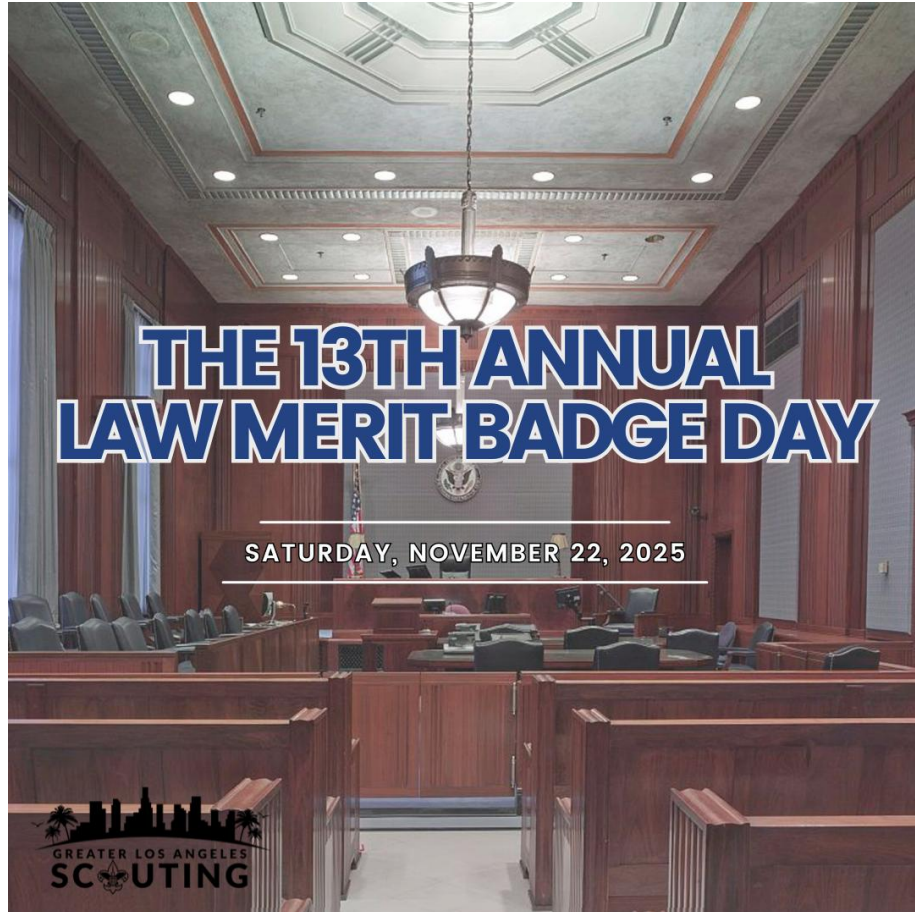

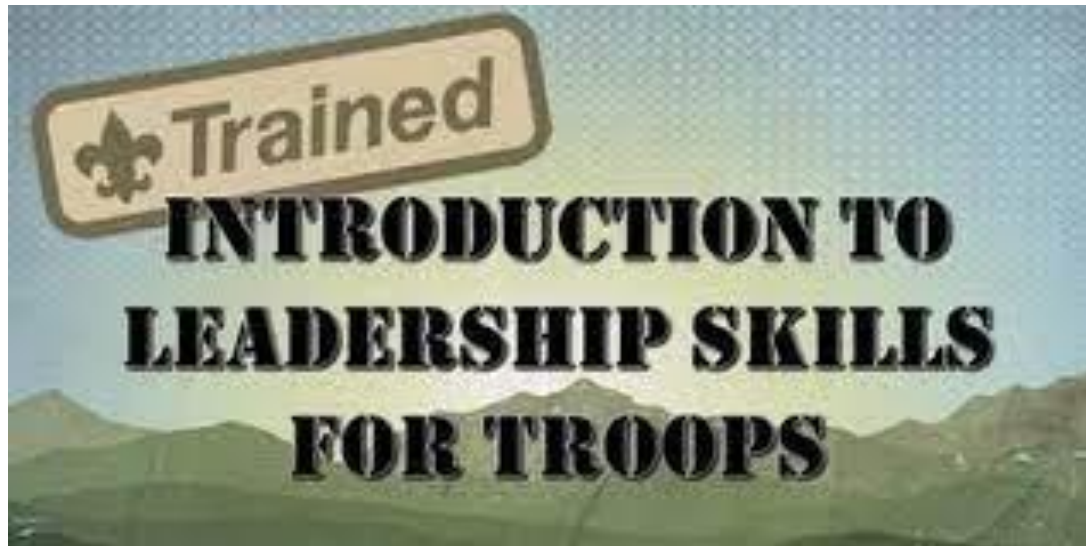

Take a Cub Scout Adventure topic available for all grades/ranks and are completed together as a pack.



Special Events

- Badge of Rank Ceremonies

- Adult Recognition
- Opening and Closing Ceremonies
 - Cub Scout meetings begin and end with a simple flag ceremony and reinforcement of the Scout Oath and Scout Law it may also include, when appropriate, the Outdoor Code or the Leave No Trace Principles for Kids. They can also incorporate other special themes for Adventures.

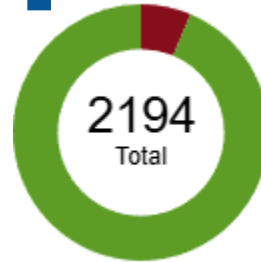

Unit Renewal

Membership renewal is now separate from unit renewal. Units will complete a simple unit renewal, verifying that all adult positions are filled and all adults have current Safeguarding Youth Training (Formerly YPT) and then pay the \$100 unit renewal fee.
